NHS South Sefton CCG does not keep a record of individual GP sickness absences. Practices are independent contractors and GPs working in each practice will either be partners or salaried (employed), therefore GP sickness records will be kept by each individual practice.

2. Can you also let me know the average amount of time the GPs have taken off for each of the diagnoses and the, shortest and longest amounts of time any GP has been away from work.
