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Re: Freedom of Information Request

Please find below the response to your recent Freedom of Information request regarding cardiac investigation services within NHS South Sefton CCG.

Request/Response:

The cardiac investigation tests are:

- a) 24-Hour Holter Monitor (also known as 24-Hour ECG)
- b) 48-Hour Holter Monitor
- c) 72-Hour Holter Monitor
- d) 7-day Holter Monitor
- e) Echocardiogram (also known as 'Cardiac Ultrasound')
- f) 24-hour Blood Pressure Monitor
- g) Exercise Tolerance test

For each of the tests stated above, please may you provide the following information from years 2014-present (financial years acceptable):

- 1. Cost of each individual test an average cost of each test as per PbR has been included.
- Number of tests requested the total number of tests carried out has been included.
- 3. Average waiting time for each test i.e. from request to examination an average waiting time as per the national diagnostics standard has been included (where applicable).
- 4. **Breach time (if any) for each test** if the patient matches the criteria for the national diagnostics standard, the target is 6 weeks.
- Cost of breaching on each said test Where the number of Service Users waiting 6 weeks or more at the end of the month exceeds the tolerance permitted by the threshold, £200 in respect of each such Service User above that threshold.
