Secondary Care Acute Services for a number of Mersey acute providers have been brought together to "Act as One". (Acting as One contract arrangement is a block contract agreement.)

2. What is the total value of variant contracts as a proportion of total?

The value is circa £86.2m which represents 68.49% of the contracts.

The proportion of services is 68.49% valued at £86.2m.
