Please find below the response to your recent Freedom of Information request regarding expenditure during covid-19 pandemic within NHS South Sefton CCG.

1. How much have you been allocated by the £1.3bn fund to support faster patient discharges from hospital during the covid-19 pandemic?

2. How much have you spent of your allocation from the £1.3bn covid-19 discharge fund?

** To note: Not all costs relating to Hospital Discharges will be incurred by the CCG. The temporary financial arrangements in place for 2020/21 mean that NHS providers will incur costs directly. The CCG does not hold this information on expenditure incurred by providers.*

3. How much has your local authority contributed towards the £1.3bn covid-19 discharge fund?

4. How many care homes did you provide oxygen to as a result of covid-19 outbreaks between:

- a. March 1st to April 15th
- b. April 15th to June 16th

[The North West Home Oxygen Services supplier is contracted to provide Home Oxygen Services on a 'named' patient basis only and as a consequence the NW HOS Contractor would not supply oxygen equipment as a 'generic' supply to a Care Home.](#)

Declaring the number of patients in each Care Home in receipt of Home Oxygen specifically for COVID-19 may enable those patients to be identified and therefore under the data protection regulations this information cannot be shared.

The CCG is unable to give any further details as we believe that disclosure of information is exempt under Section 40(2) by virtue of section 40(3) (a) (i) of the Act, where disclosure to a member of the public would contravene one or more of the data protection principles. The data protection principles are set out in Article 5 of the General Data Protection Regulation.

Section 40 is an absolute exemption therefore is not subject to the public interest test.
